<u>Courses</u>

Kingsbarns

Talked about in the same breath as famous names like Muirfield, Pebble Beach, and the Old Course. Perhaps the most celebrated course of the 21st Century, one of the best layouts in the world

Carnoustie

Constituted in 1842, Old Tom Morris redesigned and extended it to a full 18 holes in the early 1870s. One of the open Championship venues and renowned as the toughest test of them all.

Royal Aberdeen

Founded in 1780 and claims to be the sixth oldest golf club in the world. Royal Aberdeen is best known for hosting the 2011 Walker Cup Matches, and the European Tour 2014 Scottish Open.

Cruden Bay

A traditional Scottish links golf course, originally designed by Tom Morris of St. Andrews and Archie Simpson in 1899 and re-designed in the 1920's by Tom Simpson and Herbert Fowler.

Castle Stuart

As Turnberry is to Ayrshire and Gleneagles is to Perthshire, Castle Stuart has been conceived to be fr the Highlands - a beacon reaching out to golfers throughout the world.

The Nairn

Having held the Walker Cup Matches in 1999, the Nairn Golf Club's truly remarkable feature is that every hole you can see the Moray Firth and the golden colouring / changing lights of the Black Isle.

Royal Dornoch

It's the timeless setting that makes Royal Dornoch such a pleasing place to play golf. It's wild, isolated and at the same time, absolutely beautiful; there's the blaze of colour in early summer when the gorse is in flower. The pure white sandy beach divides the links from the Dornoch Firth and it all feels very humbling.

Turin House Hotel

Built in 1659 the 5 star Turin Castle sits in twenty acres of sweeping lawns with majestic views of the rolling Scottish countryside.

Mary Culter House Hotel

Idyllic 4 star Hotel with beautiful views over the River Dee
